Installation Instructions

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Detach closing springs from frame to allow panels to remain open during installation. Leave springs attached to the bracket on the back of the panel to allow faster "re-assembly" later.
- Slide the RETURN FLANGE of Access Door into opening. (Side with bolt(s) will need to be "notched" to allow for Bolt Cover - see diagram above).
- 3. If unit shall be installed into a masonry brick, masonry straps have been provided to fold out & be placed between bricks prior to mortar drying.
- 4. Open panel to access mounting holes in RETURN FLANGE.
- 5. Screw through the mounting holes, through fire-rated drywall and into joist system. If the wall/ceiling is concrete or brick, then bolt directly into the masonry through mounting holes.
- 6. Keys and Knobs for this unit are usually taped to the back of the panel for shipping. This is a self-closing, self-latching unit. Before closing unit, make sure that all Keys & Knobs for the unit's flush lock(s) are in hand & not still taped to the back of the door panel. After mounting screws are in place close unit.
- 7. Paint the unit if necessary. (Stainless Steel Units or Mill Finish, do **not** require painting).
- 8. Re-Attach closing spring from bracket on the back of the panel to holes provided on the Hinge Side of frame.
- 9. When working in a ceiling, this may become a 2-man project to hold the heavy unit in place. The insulated FW-5050 can be heavy depending on its size.

^{*}Note-Both Flush Keys and Knurled Knob are enclosed for the installer's convenience.
