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Roof Hatch Installation Instructions (Onto Flat Roof Only)

- 1. Prepare the hole in the roof deck to match the Roof Hatch's inside dimension.
- 2. For large hatches 6' 0" x 6' 0" and larger, the roof should be prepared with structural members capable of supporting the hatch's weight. For weight determination, use 20 pds / per square foot of the hatch's size. (Ex. For a 6' x 6' hatch, the weight would be 720 pds).
- 3. Set the unit down onto the roof deck.
- 4. Line up the inside opening of the unit with the hole prepared in the roof deck.
- 5. Nail or Screw directly into the roof through the predrilled mounting holes in the Roof Hatch's (Self Flashing) Flange.
- 6. Lay the cant (by others) down on top of the Roof Hatch's flange in such a way that it is flush with the unit's insulated Curb Wall. The cant should not extend further than the Roof Hatch Cover's edge.
- 7. Bring roof-flashing materials and sealants over the Roof Hatch Flange, over the Cant, and up under the Curb Frame/Flashing. (See detail below).
- 8. Our galvanized roof hatch comes finished with a gray primer coat of paint. It needs to be painted with a weather-resistant coat to finish installation. (Our aluminum roof hatch is furnished with a Mill Finish and does not require painting in order to complete installation).
